

# Taking an iPad photo



## Top tips for photographing your art!



#### Open your camera app

- 1) To take a photo, press on the camera app to open up the camera.
- 2) Press the large circular button on the screen to take a photo.



Natural light by an open door is good!



Try to avoid shadows!

#### **Natural Light**

Daylight is best! Take your photograph during the day. Find a place that is **very light** - on the floor by an open door is perfect.

Place the picture or photograph in the light and make sure you can't see any shadows on your work.



Stand with your feet level

Portrait



Match the corners of paper with the screen so they line up



#### **Perspective**

Stand with your feet level, looking straight at your picture.

Match the iPad screen with the shape of the paper so the corners of the paper fit the corners of your iPad screen.

If your picture is **portrait**, hold your iPad like a phone. If it's **landscape**, hold your iPad to the side.



Blurry picture from movement



Final picture can be cropped and edited.

### **Keeping Still**

When you press the button to take the photograph, keep as still as you can for 3 seconds and hold the iPad as still as you can. This will stop the picture looking blurry.

Take more than one photo. You can choose the best one!
