









Creating a comic strip!

This week we are going to create a comic strip, or short picture story using your character that you created. It can be introducing your character, where they live and about them or it can be a short story or action scene!

What you could use

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Paper, pencils, pens
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Paints, pastels, or anything you use to create your comic!
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Collage material (pictures or paper torn or cut from old magazines) glue and scissors

	<p>Start by drawing four boxes, or print out the guide.</p>
<p>My character Pow Pigeon</p>  <p>My comic story plan</p>  <p>Box 1: A picture of character with speech bubble saying: "I'm Pow Pigeon."</p> <p>Box 2: "I was a normal pigeon until I fell into a vat of radioactive waste!"</p> <p>Box 3: "Now I'm POW Pigeon." Superhero!</p>	<p>Under each box you can write what will happen in that box.</p>
	<p>You can use speech bubbles for your character talking, or thinking!</p>
	<p>Then, start drawing your story! Or, you could cut out pictures from magazines to make your comic strip</p>
